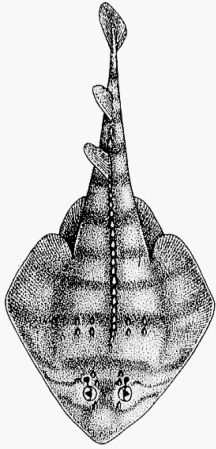


COMMON RAYS & SHARKS NEAR CALIFORNIA PIERS

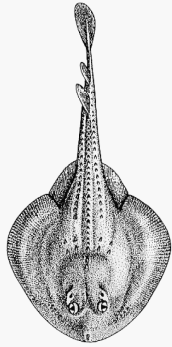

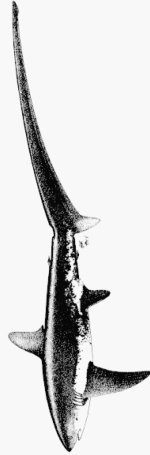

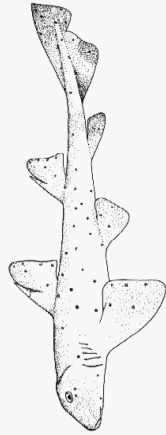

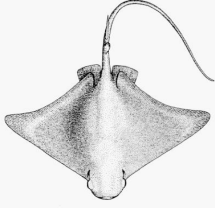

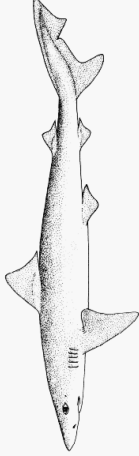

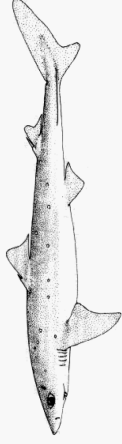

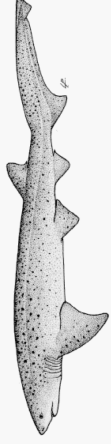
